I have now spent 16 Birthdays in prison. I was 16 when I was arrested. Often it feels like there is no end in sight for when my freedom will be restored. We had the evidentiary hearing in January of 2017 where we proved everything; yet we are still waiting on the magistrates ruling. As we wait I have decided to file a commutation request to Governor Gerry Brown. Governor Brown is granting more commutations than ever before and while we wait on the magistrates ruling there is no reason not to try this as well.

As part of my commutation request I can include support letters from friends and family. These support letters can carry great weight in the Governor's decision to grant a request for commutation.
